Hello once again. So finishes a very busy but productive month in Mozambique. Business friend and one of Moz Outreach's directors Keith

Robinson, accompanied me to Mozambique last month. Our agenda was packed full of God inspired meetings and surprises. Thank you Lord for your Divine appointments.

Our New Land in Boane - Maputo

After negotiations with Veloso and associates it was formally agreed (in writing) to give Mozambique Outreach the exclusive use of 20 - 25 acres of land in the Boane region just outside of Maputo city. In essence we have adopted a community of 500 families (2500 people) mainly consisting of widows and children. We intend to set up our national headquarters here, with

churches, school, MozBIZ, radio and prayer centre.

Our first priority though is to get clean drinking water to these beautiful widows. We watched them hauling 20 litre containers full of river water back the one and a half kilometres to their homes. And the water is full of disease, mainly cholera.

At an average cost of \$1500USD, someone has already kindly offered to pay for the first of the three water bores required to service the community. Chief Samuel Umpala welcomes us and has invited us to start the first church in the area.

Construction on the compound will start as soon as possible.

Reaching The Unreached For Jesus

In South Africa we met with World Mission Centre and have made an offer of the use of our Beira facilities for the training of 20 people per year to go into northern Mozambique to reach the

unreached groups with the good news of Jesus. This is a huge and exciting undertaking, costing us in the order of \$20,000 USD per year, but we are very sure that this is on top of the Lord's priority for Moz Outreach.
