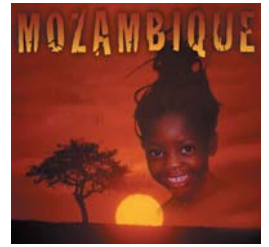

## Mutarara and Marrameo churches



Two years ago we sent Pastor Ishmael to the key area of Mutarara to preach and demonstrate the good news of Jesus and plant churches.



With very little in terms of finance or materials, but with a heart for God and for people, **Ishmael has built two thriving churches in this remote place.**

This month **we sent Pastor Manuel** from Beira to Mutarara **to encourage and train the churches** there as well as three others that have been planted in Marrameo.

The leaders there have a heart to see a Godly transformation in their villages.

Often these churches meet under a tree, or on the dirt.

We have supplied Bibles and training material for the leaders – who in turn, are teaching their



people how to love and walk with God by faith.

***Here is a brief report from Manuel's trip to Mutarara:***



*God moved powerfully. Many people were falling down under the most powerful anointing of God that I have ever experienced.*

*The churches are good. People came to experience the Lord Jesus personally, about **50 were baptised** and many people restored their faith in God, as they had been weak in their hearts about serving him. **They came knocking on my door**, continually wanting more advice about God and **asking about scriptures**. It was good but very exhausting.*

*One night I was asleep and awoke twice with **demonic spirits trying to pick me up** and carry me away. Then Pastor Ishmael awoke as well having had the*



*exact same experience. Together we prayed and prayed. After it happened a second time, Ishmael and I went outside and were going to walk around the house and pray when **a black beast ran***

***into the bush*** making a gruff noise. ***It was demon***. We both just looked at each other and prayed more than ever.

We currently have 10 strong churches in 5 provinces. Thank you Lord.
