We have devoted much of this edition of the MozNEWS to reporting on Gary Waters' recent trip to Mozambique.

### Gary And Liz Waters



Gary and Liz Waters are on the team of directors of Mozambique Outreach. They live in Brisbane with their four children and attend church at the Garden City AOG. Both have served in the area of missions before, having been on short-term mission trips to the Philippines.

They head up the organisations Integrity Care and Nations Of Integrity in Australia.

One of Gary's dreams is to see poverty eliminated in developing countries through the instrument of micro enterprise development. Another of his dreams is to see Godly, principal based

leadership practised at all levels of a nations government and community. He believes the proverb that "righteousness exalts a nation".

Mozambique Outreach is partnering with Nations of Integrity to see these two powerful areas of development come to a healthy fruition.

Gary travelled to Mozambique in July with son his Shanon.

### New Church In Umpala Village

The first of Gary's appointments was to open our new church in Umpala Village, Boane, with a community meeting that attracted 300 of the local people.

Umpala village is a village of 2500 widows and children.

He delivered a short message on the "Rivers of Living Water" and then gave Chief Samuel Umpala a Portuguese Bible, and then commissioned him as guardian of this copy of God's Word for this village.

## **Meeting With Senior Mozambican Officials**

While on his trip, he met with many key men. These included General Jacinto Veloso and Colonel Joaquim Mataruka who arranged **military escorts** for him while he was in Maputo. They arranged for him to address the: "Department Of National Defence" conference on the topic: "Participation of Armed Forces in the Economic Solution of Mozambique" In addition he spoke on "The High Price Of Corruption".

Gary has arranged to **provide training to the Mozambican military defence force** (currently a Peace Corps) and

also a program to **offer retiring military personnel an opportunity for an income** through the micro enterprise program. This was very well received.

Gov Zecharia arranged for Gary to meet the National Minister of state Administration, - Mr Hosea Chichava. Mr Chichava invited Gary to pilot a program to train the teachers of the

administration graduates at their own admin colleges in Maputo and Beira.

### **MozBIZ**

As mentioned previously, micro enterprise development is close to Gary's heart. MozBIZ is the practical embodiment of that dream in Mozambique.

So far there have been 45 businesses funded in the MozBIZ program. This means that potentially nearly 700 people have emerged out of poverty through this ministry in only 10 months. Praise God!

### **Training**

The number of attendees at the fortnightly business training has more than doubled since June. 80 people attended Gary's teaching at the MozOutreach compound in Beira – a testimony of the Lord's blessing and the dedication of Francis N'Sona – who leads MozBIZ in Mozambique.
