Natalia was a poor mother who lost her child to malaria, now she is a **successful business woman**, supporting her husband's ministry.

Perhaps you think that you can't do some-

thing because you haven't been trained to do it, or because someone told you

that you were not qualified. I would say to you: **admit that you are limited or inadequate to do the job** and then either train yourself or **link**



up with someone who can. With our Saviour's unlimited supply of encouragement and blessing and His promise to never leave or forsake you, you might just find that you will do things **beyond** your dreams.
