The **six teachers** at our school are currently **attending a New Christians Course** as part of their spiritual development.

They are **very keen to learn more about God** and are asking questions which show they are thinking about what I am teaching them and how it applies to their lives.

We meet once a fortnight on a Saturday morning and I am enjoying getting to know them better.

I have also **prepared a daily bible reading/devotional programme** which they are **implementing in the classroom**. It is great to know that we are providing some spiritual input for the children in this way and the teachers are happy to use the material which I have prepared for them.

Parents Contribute

Our school now has an organised parent body. As the community sees the school grow, their support for what we are doing is also growing. At the end of term parents meeting which Emma and I

attended, we were encouraged to see that the parents were **not just accepting a handout, but were willing to attempt to contribute to the school** in some way.

They decided that they should do **some work on the grounds** and consequently came the following Saturday to work. They also decided that they would **each donate a brick towards construction**.

Latrine Shopping

I never expected to have to **learn the intricacies of pit latrines**, but here I have found there are many different kinds of latrines.

We need to **build some pit latrines** at school for the students to use, and as we want good latrines which will last a long time, I needed to know that we were building the right one.

So Alice, the principal, said she would **take me on a tour and show me some different types of latrines!!** My mind boggled at the possibility of **traipsing around the village investigating latrines for cleanliness, use-ability and smell!!**

Fortunately I was somewhat misled and there is actually a place that manufactures concrete tops for latrines in all shapes and sizes, so it was simply a matter of going to the place and checking out which style is best.

It wasn't at all the challenging experience which I had expected, but of course I am very relieved about that.

I met with Religious Affairs Dondo to explain our strategy for planting churches in the city. After some discussion, **they 'officially' welcomed us.**

Senior David, who we met with, requested that we provide him with our monthly plan for Dondo so that **he is able to attend some of the New Christian classes.**
