On my last trip to Moz in November, I remember that she came to the meeting strapped to her brother’s back - a pile of skin and bones, and I remember 2 things; firstly that she was in a horribly pathetic state and secondly I remember asking her - “Do you want to die at 15?”. She cried and said “I don’t want to die”. As a team, we prayed for her and said “You won’t die, be healed in the Name of Jesus”.

At a conference meeting this month for pastors, a young girl walked up to me and said “Do you remember me?” I looked at her and a spark of recognition caused me ask - “Did we pray for you on my last trip?” “Yes” she replied, “God healed me. Now I can walk and I go to school”. It was Rosa! She is completely healed. Praise the Lord.

Call them to salvation through Christ Jesus, to integrity, to purity of actions, words and intent, to inward holiness and guiltless actions, to enter into right standing with their God.

Declare Moz missionaries "receive blessing from the Lord".

Declare their righteousness before God through Christ Jesus.

Herald the entry of the King of Glory to the nations (Vs 7-10).

Proclaim the everlasting victory of Christ over His enemies.

Proclaim His victory, might and His strength over the spiritual enemies of our missionaries.

Command the gates of the nations to open for the victorious entry of Christ Jesus.

Command open gates of every individual heart, home, city, region, people group & nation with which Moz missionaries come in contact, for the victorious entry of Christ Jesus."

5. Prayer – This thing we do

Having done all – STAND. Eph. 6:10-17 encourages us to be spiritually prepared with the armour of God, to be able to engage in spiritual warfare as men and women of God fully equipped by Him.
