## Claremont Baptist Team - Wired For Power



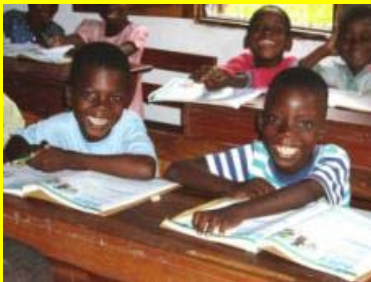
