General Ministry - Emma Jones

Praise - For the Lord's continued provision of finance needed within the ministry both in Aus and Moz.

- For a good relationship with other ministries in Beira who are able to share resources with MozO, assist our ministry, pray and develop friendships and contacts throughout Moz.

Prayer - Pray for Ps Sabe, who is assisting the ministry with the organisation of the legal paperwork required by the Mozambique government. He needs wisdom as he deals with the Dept of Religious Affairs.

5. Praying the Word of God – Dale Allen

This is the Muslim month of Ramadan. Build the kingdom of heaven around Mozambique by praying Matt 3:1-6.

Vs 1 Declare a way made in the spiritual desert and wilderness in the nations, for prophetic preaching to come, as John the Baptist came to Judea. Declare that prophetic teaching has come to all Muslim people in Mozambique.

Release a spirit of repentance over all Muslim areas of Mozambique where our missionaries work or are planning to work - Lichinga and Maputo. Call all those in the spiritual wilderness in the 10 provinces of Moz to have their minds transformed, to think differently, to recognise, regret and confess their sins and to permanently change their conduct.

Vs 2 Proclaim 'the kingdom of heaven is at hand', that the rule of God, that God's kingdom has come to Muslims. Declare that the prophetic Word of God is confirmed in all places of spiritual wilderness and desert in Mozambique.

Vs 3 Use the spiritual authority you have in Christ Jesus to command the Muslim nations and all nations to 'make ready a way for the Lord, make His highway level and straight', to make preparation for the Lord's coming.

Vs 4 Pray that Christians will live simple, healthy, pure lives, free of self-indulgence as godly role models. See in the spiritual realm and prophesy Matt 3:5,6 that 'all the country', all those who have heard the Gospel and all those who are far away from it, will come to Christ's true representatives to be 'baptized...confessing their sins'.

6. Prayer – This thing we do

James says that a double minded man is unstable in all his ways (James 1:8). Previously James encourages us to ask for wisdom. This wisdom is required to deal with the issues of life. However, having asked for wisdom, there can be no room for doubting - no double mindedness. God rewards those who diligently seek Him. But He says to ask in faith with no doubting.

Also you'll notice we're not to ask for the latest gismo here, we're asking for God's divine wisdom in how to proceed through the trials of life and be one who overcomes to the praise and glory of God. So settle it in your heart; my God loves me and will give wisdom to me liberally and without reproach.
