## Tearing Holes In Your Own Mosquito Net

The Lord showed me that by serving 2 masters it was like sleeping in a mosquito net with holes in it. The covering of the Lord was like the net. It kept the mosquitoes out - the enemy!

But when a person went to the witchdoctor it was like they went to their mosquito net and voluntarily tore holes in the net. This caused openings in their life for the enemy (the mosquito) to get in.

By going to the witchdoctor, it wasn't the devil tearing the wholes but the people themselves.

I shared with them that if they made a decision to serve the Lord only, then He would not just remove the holes, he would give them a whole new net. The covering of the Lord over their life would be complete again and the enemy had no way of entering.

So, from that illustration, everyone in the church closed their eyes and I invited people to stand and repent before the Lord if they had been going to the witchdoctor.

To start with one of the ladies stood up and actually started to confess before the whole church her sin of going to the witchdoctor. It was powerful.

Then 3 other women stood up. All the people in the church had their eyes closed. This was something between them and the Lord. But together, we said a prayer of confession and repentance. God is so good.
