## Adventure to Buzi Literacy in Demand

The response in Buzi for the literacy program was overwhelming. I had a moment of "how on earth are we going to do this". After a private regroup with the Holy Spirit I think it is going to be a great process that will be easily multiplied in other areas.

I had 10 head pastors from Assemblies of God churches and traditional churches asking for the program. Many said that they have been praying for years of such a program both for children and for adults that incorporate Christian teaching and values and literacy. So how did it go?

The information day went wonderfully. Ramiro was very happy with the questions and enthusiasm of the church leaders. We have arranged to spend a week in Buzi in four weeks visiting each one of the areas in need of this



program.

Earlier, we had been introduced to a young man named Elias who has just finished Bible College and is itching to serve in ministry. When Emma asked him what he wanted to do now, he said without any prior knowledge of our program, he very much wanted to train teachers to teach.

We began to share with him about the vision of Rural Education. Ramiro took over and filled him in on more of the details.

The introduction ended with Elias preaching about the need for good teaching to take the gospel to those who are yet to hear of the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Elias was an inspiration to our trip and added the missing element that only God could have recognised what was needed.

He was strong and assertive with the leaders, challenging them to see the value of this program in the kingdom of God and that they had to do their part.

As a Mozambican he was received very well and then he got them to pray and worship God. WOW.

## Chief's Heart Touched

The Lord has been building in my heart a vision for a prayer centre where all could join and pray.

I had been whispering to the Lord about a certain location that would be mighty and impacting due to location, size and suitability.

The Vitoria, an old cinema that needs a lot of work but has loads of potential.

I had a meeting with the local Chief about what an amazing place this could be for the community, seeing churches joining together for prayer and worship, counselling and prayer for the sick, youth gatherings and teaching on every area of ministry.
