Northern Base - Lichinga



We visited the Wilcox Family at our northern base in Lichinga. On this base, near the Lichinga airport, the Wilcox's are building a new house for their family and accommodation for several orphaned children.

Each morning the air is filled with the **sound of singing** as their family starts their day with praise and worship and prayer.

They have a prayer house made from reeds which doubles as a training centre. An old model **Land Rover** gets them around, but not too quickly. (See picture)

Annelise and Antoinette are working with Iris Ministries looking after orphans and Peter and Debbie are working with the locals **making disciples**. They are planning to reach out into the Yao community where as yet there is **still no New Testament** translated.

The Yao people have a culture steeped in witchcraft and largely closed off to outsiders. Young girls are ritually 'circumcised' and abused by the men of the villages.
